# 2) Do I need to take a placement test before signing up for a course?

# 3) When, where and how do I register for the placement test?

# When?

Registration for the placement tests: You can register for a placement test(s) from 07.04.2025 until 23.04.25 (23:59).

Placement tests take place on the following days:

English, French, German, Italian, Spanish: 16. + 17.4.25 and 23. + 24.4.25

All other languages: 23 + 24.4.25 (limited number of slots depending on the language)

You will receive information about exact times and venues when you sign up.

Enter the following <u>numbers</u> in the search field (,Suchen ...') and then select a slot. You take a test in more than one language but you cannot book two slots on the same day.

Registration for French + Italian	opens 24.04.25 at 11.00	midnight on 04.05.25	
Registration for <b>Russian</b>	opens 24.04.25 at 12.00

# 5) What do I need to bear in mind when I sign up for a course at the Language Centre?

- When courses start All courses offered by the Language Centre start in the second week of the semester, i.e. in the week beginning 28 April.
- o Class times and venues You will see this when you register on CMlife.
- Attendance regulations Almost all language courses offered by the Language Centre are taught inperson on campus. Regular attendance is mandatory, but a limited number of absences is permitted Attendance regulations for language courses (uni-bayreuth.de)
- **De-registration** You can de-register from a course you no longer wish to attend up until 4 May but please note that de-registration is no longer possible after this date.
